1. Use a dictionary to write the definitions for ten spelling words.

2. Write a letter to a friend using at least ten of your spelling words. Underline the spelling words you use. Punctuation counts!

3. Write your twenty words one time each using one color for vowels and a different color for consonants.

1. Make a word train! Neatly write each word end to end like one long word, but use a different color for each new word.

2. Write your spelling words three times each in *cursive*.

3. Use Wordle.net to create a word cloud with all twenty of your spelling words. Print it out and bring it to class.

1. Make a collage for ten of your words. Cut out letters from newspapers or magazines and glue them together to spell your chosen words.

2. Write all twenty words in alphabetical order, one on each line.

3. Write a sentence for each of ten spelling words showing that you understand their meanings. Underline the spelling words you use. Do not use the same subject more than once.
